

Volunteer Posting – Boundaries Program Facilitator

Eagles Nest is looking for a volunteer as a Boundaries *Program Facilitator*. Along with skills to facilitate courses and support people navigating difficult situations, this individual needs to align with our values and be passionate about working for an organization committed to making a difference in the lives of others.

For more than 20 years Eagles Nest Association of Waterdown has been positively impacting families in the community with compassion and practical support.

Eagles Nest works with individuals looking to make change happen in a supportive and positive environment. We help people care for their mental health, learn new tools for healthy relationships and develop self-worth. We offer counselling, coaching and support programs to adults, youth and children. Our services are low cost with subsidies available to help make them accessible to everyone. We welcome everyone for who they are, without regard to religion, ethnicity, race, gender or sexuality.

Volunteer Description:

The Volunteer will assist in program facilitation with another volunteer facilitator. The Boundaries course is a video book study and facilitated peer group discussion. This course runs for 8 weeks with a fall, winter (virtual) and spring session. This course is run out of the HOPE Centre facility under the supervision of the Program Manager.

Responsibilities:

- Responsibilities may change with the course offered but general responsibilities may include:
 - Liaise with Eagles Nest staff to arrange program specifics
 - Prepare for program which may include ordering, reviewing and/or creating materials
 - Present program which may include connecting with the program coordinator, presenting course materials, facilitating discussions, referring course participants to additional services provided by Eagles Nest or community organizations as required
 - Participate in mandatory training for Eagles Nest Volunteers and Plan 2 Protect ®

Qualifications:

- Prior experience with course material an asset but not required
- Compassionate, non-judgmental, empathetic listener
- Ability to follow and respect confidentiality requirements
- Ability to uphold the Mission, Identity, Faith Statement and Values of Eagles Nest while volunteering
